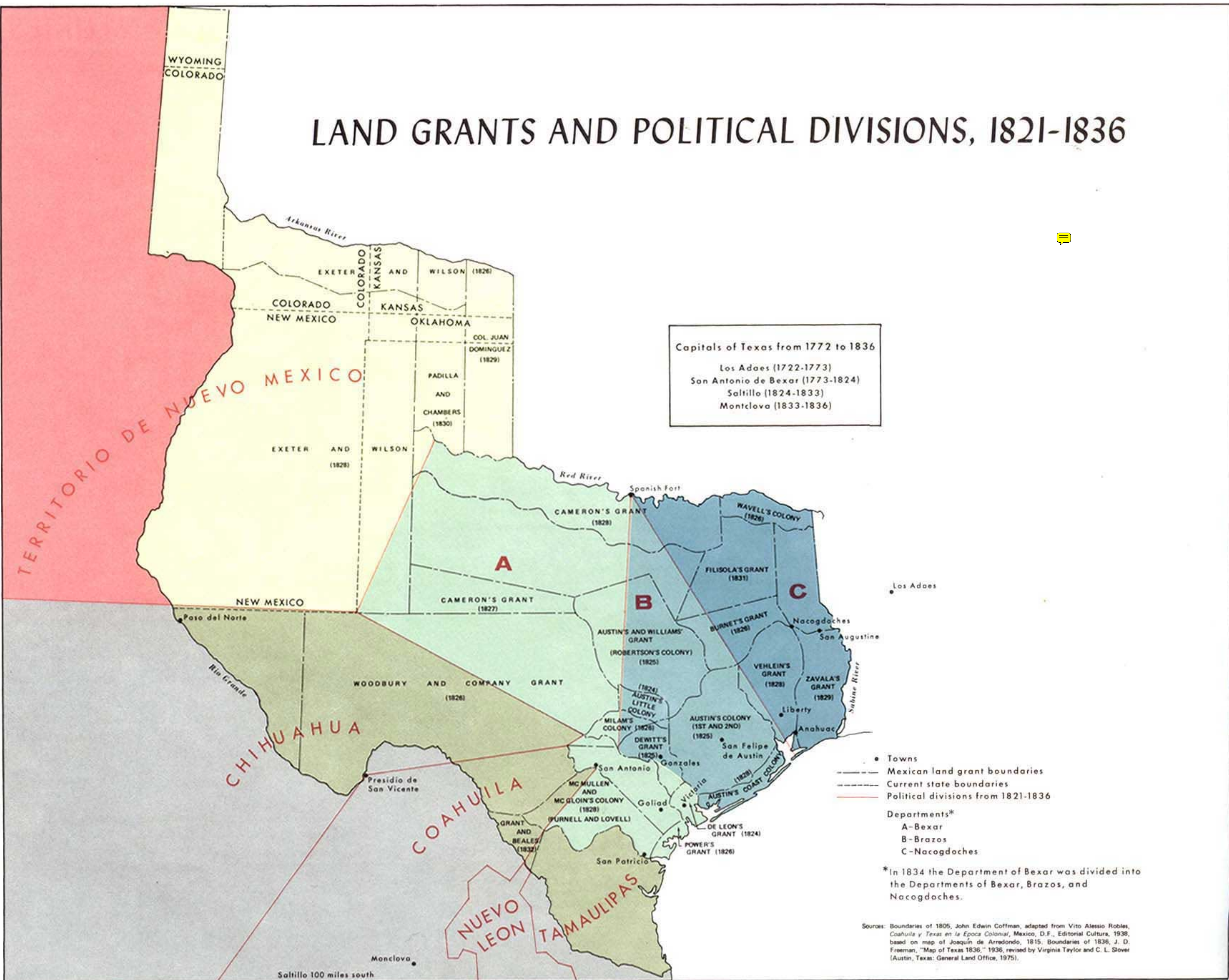


# LAND GRANTS AND POLITICAL DIVISIONS, 1821-1836
